Vehicle Safety Inspection Checklist

Vehicle Safety Inspection

- Wheel lug nut correct torque
- Tire condition and inflation
- Suspension integrity
- Secure ballast and test equipment
- External vehicle lighting
- Brake system components and fluid level
- Parking brake operation
- Secure all loose objects in passenger compartment
- Ck. 5th wheel attachment
- Two-way radio
- Strobe beacon (if necessary)

High Cg Vehicles (Items as necessary)

- Roll Bar
- Outriggers
- Five-point harness
- Safety seats

Non-program dedicated vehicles

These vehicles will be subject to the requirements as stated above per Bosch associate review. These vehicles will be evaluated for safe speeds and the allowed maneuvers prior to track use. Track users are urged to submit the vehicle for inspection several days before the intended date of use. Vehicles may be restricted from all or part of their intended use based on the findings of the safety inspection and evaluation. Vehicles brought by the customer on the day of the event may be disallowed due to the lack of manpower to perform the necessary inspection and evaluation. On a case-by-case basis, vehicles may be exempt from the above mentioned guidelines only if three Bosch managers and/or directors agree to the specific exemption. It is the responsibility of the user to acquire and document the exemption well in advance of the desired usage dates.
